

I will continue to improve and develop my skill set with updates to my portfolio showing a key development in progression that potential employers will be able to see, including the passion I put into my work!





We understand that making the decision to study at degree level is a big commitment both financially and personally, but there is a lot of information and support available to you.



Student Loan

All eligible, full-time and part-time undergraduate students are able to apply for a student loan to cover the cost of their course fees. You will not pay back any of your course fees until your income is over £25,000 a year.

Study Enhancement Gift

All new, first-year (level 4), full-time undergraduates studying a qualifying Foundation Degree, Bachelor's Degree or Higher National Diploma at University Centre St Helens, will receive a non-repayable Study Enhancement Gift up to the value of £400. This could be a specific gift, such as a laptop, or subject specific equipment, extra qualifications or trips and visits.

Access to Higher Education

Our one-year Access to Higher Education qualifications are designed to help you gain the skills and qualifications you need to successfully apply for a university-level course.

Access to HE qualifications also offer direct progression to degrees at University Centre St Helens.
